## **Transparency Rules:**

- 1. Professional, licensed access and/or lay clients (as appropriate) may contact an individual barrister or chambers to obtain a quotation for legal services;
- 2. Factors which might influence the timescales of the barrister or chambers most commonly provided legal services are when a barrister may be at court, engaged in dispute resolution, in a conference.

- 4. Fees do not include VAT and an hourly rate of £325 is levied, which may be varied depending upon the complexity of the instruction. Additional costs may include filing fees, court fees, copying fees, postage fees and travel/subsistence costs.
